AIR RADON INSTRUCTIONS



It is **ILLEGAL** to test (collect) a residence or its water supply for radon if you neither own nor rent the home, **UNLESS YOU ARE REGISTERED** with the State of Maine Radon Program. Similarly, if you are in the process of buying or selling your home, you are also prohibited by Maine's "Radon Registration Act" from doing the testing yourself. You must hire a State of Maine Registered Radon Tester. Post mitigation (system verification) testing can be conducted by the homeowner or resident of the structure after install of a new system. DO NOT open the vial until you have read these instructions! PLEASE SAVE ALL PACKAGING. It will be used to return the vial. If you have any question, please call (207) 784-5354.

The initial test should be made under closed house conditions. All doors and windows shall be closed 12 hours before the test begins and remain closed (except for normal entry and exit) for the duration of the exposure. Turn off all whole house exhaust fans and minimize the use of kitchen and bathroom fans during the test.

Place vial in the lowest livable area of the home. The basement (or cellar) is considered "livable" if only usual renovation would be needed to convert it into living space. DO NOT PLACE THE VIAL IN CRAWL SPACES, BASEMENTS UNDER 6 FT IN HEIGHT, KITCHENS OR BATHROOMS. Avoid placement near doors, windows, fireplaces and outside walls.

Instructions for Use

Vials **MUST** be sealed with original screw cap. **DO NOT** write or put tape anywhere on the vial. Writing on the vial may cause the sample to be rejected. **DO NOT** remove or tamper with the serial number sticker.







1. Place the vial in the area chosen for the test and remove the cover. Keep the screw cover near the vial.
2. Place the vial on a chair or table 20-30 inches off the floor where it will not be disturbed for the duration of the sampling period (48 -96 hours). DO NOT PLACE THE VIAL ON THE FLOOR.
3. Using the reverse side of this form, record the date and time that the vial is opened.
4. Keep the vial open for a minimum of 48 hours (2 days) no longer than 4 days. At the end of the test period, close the vial with the original screw cap.
5. Complete the information requested on the reverse side of this sheet.
6. BE SURE TO RECORD THE DATE AND TIME THAT THE VIAL WAS OPENED AND CLOSED. FAILURE TO INCLUDE THIS INFORMATION COULD SERIOUSLY DELAY YOUR RESULTS.
7. Place the closed vial and the chain of custody sheet back in the original package. Enclose a check for the cost of the test and attach the laboratory's address label to the outside of the package. Mail the package within 24 hours of completing the test. Sample(s) need to be received and processed within 4 days of completing the test. Take into consideration weekends and holidays when sampling and mailing the vial. A & L Laboratory uses test methods approved by the State of Maine and the United States Environmental Protection Agency. We assume that all information regarding this test is the same as indicated on the reverse side of this sheet.

The State of Maine requires the reporting of radon test results in accordance with the Act (22 MRSA sec. 771 et seq.) The following information for all tests completed by A & L Laboratory will be reported to the state on a monthly basis: Zip code, sample ID#, radon laboratory result, floor tested, street address of the building, town and if there is a mitigation system currently installed.
